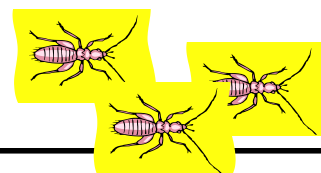
SRC Inductions

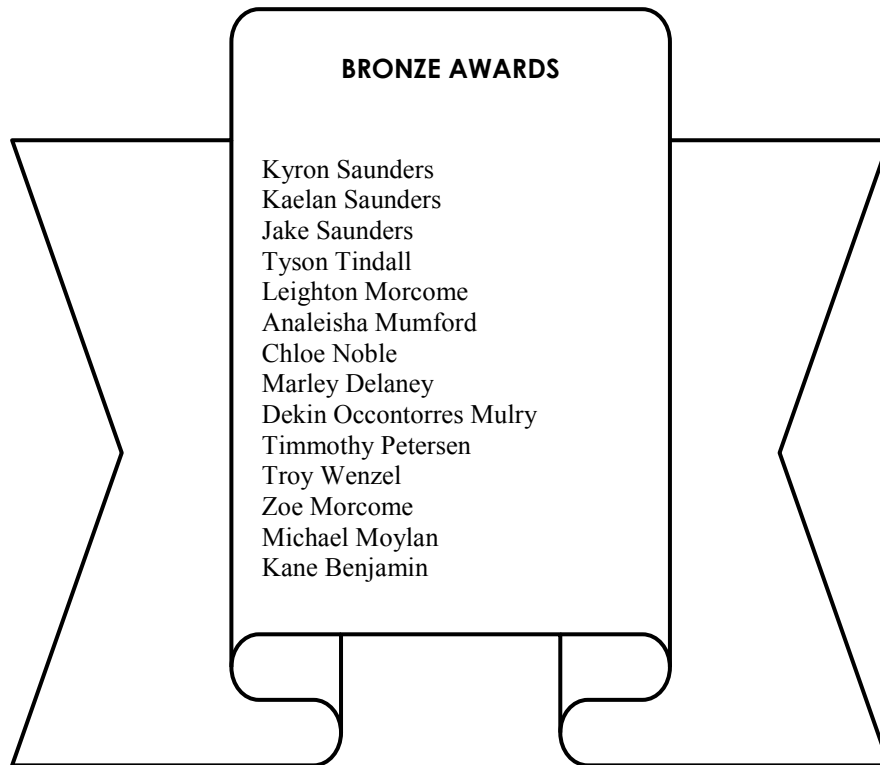
