#### **New Curriculum - English**

In the new English curriculum Taree PS teachers use and adapt units of work designed by the NSW department of education that meet the requirements of the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA).


These units of work have two components A and B. In component A students are taught foundational literacy skills, such as phonics, spelling, handwriting and reading fluency and comprehension.

In component B students are taught about 'textual concepts' such as how a text is written, with a focus on vocabulary used and the structure and purpose of the writing for example in a narrative text students may learn about the creation of characters in the text.

Specific texts, often books are used for each unit. In K-2 a focus or 'mentor' text will be explored by the whole class and concepts taught over the two week unit.

In years 3-6 each student is given a copy of the text and concepts are taught over a five week unit. The texts are also used to develop writing skills where the students create their own texts.

Years 3 and 4 have moved on from the narrative text *Fantastic Mr Fox* by Roald Dahl and are currently working with the texts *Iceberg* by Claire Saxby and *Earth's Incredible Oceans* by Jess French to learn about a different genre which is the 'category' of the text.

# Facebook—Rules of Engagement

Tagging of parents or friends within comments/replies is permitted with the understanding that all other rules of engagement are followed.

The department encourages interaction from participants with the understanding that the department does not endorse comments/replies or wall postings made by social media users on the channel. We ask that users making comments/replies on the channel show respect for other users by ensuring discussions remain civil.

Personal attacks, trolling or spam will not be tolerated. We reserve the right to remove comments that do not adhere to the rules of engagement of our channels, including comments that: are deemed racist, sexist, abusive, profane, violent, obscene, spam; advocate illegal activity; are wildly off-topic; libel, incite, threaten or make personal character attacks.

Remember, your name and photo will be seen next to your comment, visible publicly.

We will not permit messages selling products or promoting commercial, political or other ventures.
